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### TAKASHI MURAKAMI: From Superflat to Bubblewrap

It's pretty big news that the Singapore Tyler Print Institute (STPI) will be staging Japanese contemporary art icon Takashi Murakami's first exhibition in Southeast Asia. Even if you aren't intimately familiar with his works, you'll probably have come across Murakami's vivacious motifs at some point – remember that massively popular collaboration he had with [Louis Vuitton](#)?

Titled "From Superflat to Bubblewrap", the exhibition will cover a wide range of Murakami's oeuvre – from his famous (or infamous) Superflat technique which launched his career to more recent works such as "Bubblewrap" – the artist's way of critiquing Japan's long-standing economic bubble crisis.

There will also be an artist talk (sold out already), panel discussions, film screenings, printmaking workshops and guided tours of both the exhibition and STPI's Creative Workshop in multiple languages.
