Introduction

STPI's Creative Workshop Internship Programme provides a unique opportunity for individuals to work in a professional workshop equipped with a paper mill and printmaking facilities, and under the tutelage of STPI's expert team of print and papermakers.

The Interns will assist our Print and Paper team with various projects, including works related to the STPI Visiting Artist Programme.

Intern – Print Team

The Print team is looking for a fine arts-trained Intern who can commit from October onwards. A background or training in printmaking is an added advantage.

The Intern will be working on Monday – Friday, on alternate shifts of 8.00AM – 5.00PM or 9.00 AM – 6.00PM.

General Requirements

- Interested applicants must be at least 18 years and above.
- Internship programmes are only open to Singaporeans and Permanent Residents. Students who are on student visas and are currently studying at local institutions may apply.
- Only full-time positions are offered for the internship.
- Minimum commitment period of 3 months.
- Interviews will be conducted with selected candidates; candidates to bring along necessary certifications, CVs & portfolio of works (only for workshop; preferably prints).

This is a paid internship. Candidates over 18 years old may apply. This internship programme is open to Singaporeans and Permanent Residents, or students currently studying at local institutions.
