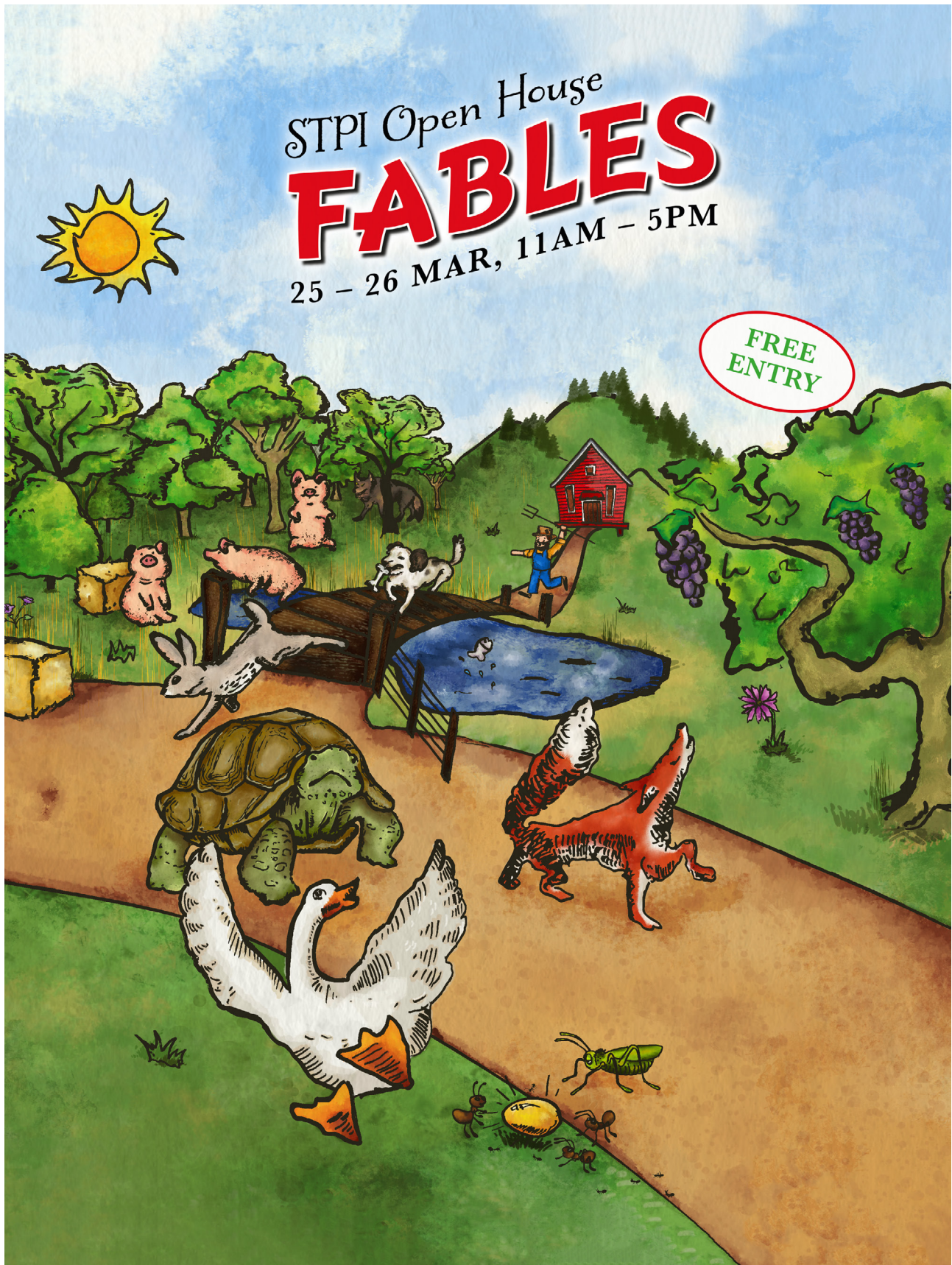

What you will learn in this workshop:

- Introduction to the tools that will be used
- Tracing of design and transferring to stamp
- Basic stamp-carving techniques
- How to ink and stamp your rubber stamp

This workshop is suitable for beginners. All tools and materials are provided. At the end of the workshop, you will take home 1-2 bookplate rubber stamps.
